Za tijesto

250g brašna (1 2/3 cups plain) Malo soli 3 jaja

2 žlica ulja (vegetable) 500ml mljeka (2 cups)

250ml mineralne vode (1 cup sparkling) Ulje za pečenje

Priprema

- U dubokoj posudi izmiješajte jaja i malo soli, pa postupno dodajte brašno, mlijeko i ulje.
- Izmiješajte mineralne-vode i ostavite tijesto da odmori 15 minuta.
- Ispecite palačinke obje strane
- Hrvatske palačinke poslužite vruće!

Steps

- In a large bowl, whisk eggs.
- Add salt, milk and oil and mix well.
- · Add flour, mix until smooth,
- Gently mix in the mineral water and rest batter in fridge for 15 minutes.
- Heat a lightly oiled frying pan over medium-high heat. Pour or scoop the batter onto the frying pan, spreading batter thinly.
- Brown on both sides and serve hot!

In Croatia, palačinke, or crepes, are one of the most loved dishes. They can be filled with savoury or sweet fillings. How will you fill your palačinke? Dobar tek!
